



# Sri Lankan Junior Science Olympiad (SLJSO)

In recognition of the growing significance of science and technology, with the aim of enhancing the development of international contacts in the field of school education in science, an annual Sri Lankan Junior Science Olympiad (SLJSO) competition is organized for school students, by the Institute of Physics, Sri Lanka (IPSL). IPSL makes necessary arrangements to participate the International Junior Science Olympiad annually, representing the country by a team of students selected from the SLJSO competition.

## International Participation

Based on the marks obtained from the local competition, the **selected best students** will be trained extensively. In the middle of the training there will be another examinations to select the **best six students** to participate for the **International Junior Science Olympiad Competition**.

## Structure of the Competition

The competition shall be conducted in Sinhala/English/Tamil media on a date decided by the IPSL. The examination paper shall consist of 50, **Multiple Choice Questions** based on Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics taught at Ordinary Level syllabus.

## Eligibility of the Competition

The contestants shall be students of Sri Lankan schools. The age of the contestants should not be exceed **sixteen years** on December 31st of the year of the competition.
